
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# 1983: Development of the Domain Name System

To replace the 'host.txt file' of network node names and their associated IP addresses




Administration/DNS of the few domains mostly by universities or individuals on a voluntary basis

Putting .SE's DS records into the root zone Since the root zone is now signed, .SE has submitted its DS records to the root zone.


